

Physician Notification Criteria: Bioflux Cardiac Monitoring Patients

The following physician notification criteria are standing orders and can be modified for any patient. This criteria sheet can be modified by the ordering or reporting physician by making the necessary changes directly to this form and returning to the Biotricity monitoring center via fax, email or through the Biotricity Patient Web Portal. The treating physician or any medical authority designated by the treating physician will be notified for each patient that meets the following criteria.
